



NOTICE

To all the customers of the Municipal District of Opportunity #17 that currently have their refuse picked up by the M.D.'s refuse truck in the areas of Wabasca, Calling Lake and Sandy Lake. The M.D. has purchased a new Automated Side Loader Refuse truck to help with efficiency and costs of refuse collection.

All the commercial bins will be replaced by 2 residential bins because the new truck will not be able to grab the larger bins. This process will be starting in early August and continuing throughout the month. Expected delivery of the truck is early to mid-September.


At that time we will be changing the days of refuse pickup. Monday will be Wabasca. Tuesday will be Sandy Lake and Calling Lake. Thursday will be our multiple pickup customers in Wabasca.

The placement of the bins for pickup will be the same as they have been for residential customers. They are to be placed the end of the driveway, 2 meters (6'6") or less from the shoulder of the main road and facing the road. If you have multiple bins at your residence they must be placed side by side with at least a minimum spacing of .3 meter (1') to accommodate the grab arms of the truck.

Seniors service remains the same with maybe some adjustment of the location of bin that will be evaluated on an individual basis.

Commercial customers will have their replacement bins in the same spot as their commercial bins were with a spacing of a minimum of .3 meter (1') between them. If there is a problem with their placement it will be evaluated individually.

Here are some examples of ideal location and spacing of refuse bins.
