TRANSPORTATION POLICY

TITLE: **Residential Hamlet Spring Clean Up**

EFFECTIVE DATE: **APRIL 10, 2008**

POLICY NUMBER:

Purpose of Policy:

This policy is intended to assist the residents in our hamlets with spring yard clean up.

Policy Statements

- 1) The hamlet spring clean up will be offered during the months of May and June.
- 2) The MD of Opportunity No. 17 wil pick up free of charge: White Goods (Refrigerators, Stoves etc), Steel Products (Old vehicles, pipe etc.), Large burnable items
- 3) A release and waiver form must be signed by the landowner prior to clean up.
- 4) The landfill hours will change to assist in the hamlet clean up.
- 5) The hamlet spring clean up is intended to assist the residents in the removal of items that would be difficult for the residents to remove for themselves.
- 6) The deadline for registration/application for the residential hamlet clean up will be May 31, 2008.
- 7) The transportation department will then pick up the items (at no cost) during the following months (weather permitting).
- 8) This program is not intended for commercial/industrial clean up.
