Round table introductions were held.

MD Council had concerns about the power outages in Wabasca in the last two years. ATCO distributed a Wabasca Feeder 5L114 Outage 2021 & 2022 data report that lists the primary and supplementary causes.

To date, there has been 191 power outages. Out of the 191 outages in 2021-2022, 25 affected more than 50 customers and the remaining 166 outages affected less than 50 customers (103 affected only 1 customer).

One concern the MD had was the response time to power outages. ATCO had no employees stationed in Wabasca but have recently hired two employees that are stationed here.

Council asked if there are training programs available for locals to fill roles. ATCO had a job fair in Fort McMurray but have had not one in Wabasca. They have re-established the RAP program but not in the MD of Opportunity.

Council asked about sponsorship opportunities. The MD of Opportunity has big corporation's doing regular business in our communities. There is a link available on the website for non-profile groups.
