BYLAW 97 - 01

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17 In the Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of establishing fees for complaints to be heard before the Assessment Review Board.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 481 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1994, Council may set fees for the provision of hearing complaints before the Assessment Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, deems it desirable to impose a fee for hearing complaints lodged before the Assessment Review Board;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, duly assembled, hereby adopts the following:

RESIDENTIAL/FARMLAND:

- 1. A fee of \$25.00 shall be levied per roll number for all appeals lodged with the Assessment Review Board
- 2. The fee is refundable upon a successful appeal or at the discretion of the Assessment Review Board.

NON-RESIDENTIAL:

- 1. A fee of \$150.00 shall be levied per roll number for all appeals lodged with the Assessment Review Board.
- 2. The fee is refundable upon a successful appeal or at the discretion of the Assessment Review Board.

This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon signing.
