

BYLAW 98 - 05

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17 In The Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District to establish a road closure bylaw.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-26.1, Section 22 (1) requires a road closure be established by bylaw, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 now deems it necessary and expedient to pass a bylaw providing for a road closure;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That portion of the road allowance lying Northwesterly of and adjacent to the Northwesterly boundary of River Lot 4 as shown on Plan of Wabiskaw Settlement signed at Ottawa, on the 24th day of December, 1914


is to be permanently closed.

READ a first time this 13 day of May, 1998.

READ a second time this 10 day of June, 1998.

READ a third time and finally passed this 10 day of June, 1998.
