

BYLAW 98-15

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO 17 In The Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District to establish a road closure bylaw

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-26.1, Section 22 (1), requires a road closure be conducted by bylaw, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 now deems it necessary and expedient to pass a bylaw providing for a road closure;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. That the portion of the road lying between Wabasca Indian Reserves 166B and 166D, being in Township 80, Range 25, West of the fourth meridian, and containing 4.47 hectares more or less, as shown on the plan of survey of pipeline right of way, prepared by Universal Surveys Inc. under job 97-978 and marked in red be permanently closed.

READ a first time this 25th day of November 1998.

READ a second time this 25th day of November 1998.

READ a third time and finally passed this 27th day of January 1999.
