BYLAW 2004 - 07

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO 17 In The Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District to establish a road closure bylaw creating title to a new registered road plan in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, and Revised Statutes of Alberta 1994, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 now deems it necessary that the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the road closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to a subdivided lot and,

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and,

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, duly assembled, does hereby close to public travel consolidating portions of the original road alignment the following described road, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

All that portion of the access road shown in blue on Registered Plan 042-1368, Lying within portion of SE ¼ of Section 36, Township 89, Range 5, West of the fifth Meridian and within portion of SW ¼ of Section 31, Township 89, Range 4, West of the fifth Meridian.
