

## BYLAW 2004 - 3

### A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17 In the Province of Alberta

*To establish a permanent electors register in the municipality who are entitled to vote in an Election.*

---

**WHEREAS** Section 49 of the *Local Authorities Election Act* empowers a municipality, by bylaw, to prepare a permanent electors register of residents in the municipality who are entitled to vote in an election; and

**WHEREAS** this permanent electors register may be used for the 2004 Municipal Election or as otherwise authorized by Council and the Local Authorities Election Act;

**NOW THEREFORE** the council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts the following:

1. **Title:**

- a) This bylaw shall be cited as The Permanent Electors Register for the Municipal District of Opportunity.

2. **Definitions:**

In this Bylaw:

- a) "Municipality" means the corporation of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17;
- b) "Chief Administrative Officer" means the Manager of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17;

3. **Purpose:**

The Chief Administrative Officer or his/her designate is authorized to:

- a) Establish the procedures and forms necessary to complete an enumeration in the communities of Wabasca, Calling Lake, Sandy Lake, Chipewyan Lake, Trout Lake, Peerless Lake, Loon Lake and Red Earth Creek;
- b) Establish methods of compiling and revising the permanent registry;
- c) Enter into an agreement with the Chief Electoral Officer under the Local Authorities Election Act to share information for the purpose of preparing a Provincial list of electors.

4. That Bylaw 2004 – 3 becomes effective on the date of the third and final reading thereof.

Read a first time this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January 2004.

Read a second time this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January 2004.

Read a third time and finally passed this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January 2004.
