

BYLAW 2005 -1
OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO 17
In The Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity to establish a road closure bylaw creating title to a new registered road plan and consolidating portions of the road in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-261, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 now deems it necessary that the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the road closed, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to a new subdivision consolidating the original road plan to the newly created lots, and,

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and,

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, duly assembled, does hereby close to public travel consolidating portions of the original road allowance the following described proposed plan of subdivision, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

Firstly:

Meridian 4, Range 25, Township 80
All that portion of the Statutory Government Road Allowance
Adjacent to the North West of Section 23
Lying within the limits of Lots 1, 2, 5, 6 & 7
Block 2, Plan 04 _____
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

Secondly:

Meridian 4, Range 25, Township 80
All that portion of the Statutory Government Road Allowance
Adjacent to the North West of Section 23
Lying within the limits of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 & 15
Block 4, Plan 04 _____
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

Thirdly:

All that portion of the Avenue as shown on Plan 892-1936.

All as shown hatched on Schedule "A"
