

BYLAW 2005 - 2

**OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17
In the Province of Alberta**

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 to establish a Senior Citizen Exemption Utility Bylaw.

WHEREAS Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, authorizes Council to pass a bylaw with respect to the services provided by or on behalf of the municipality;

WHEREAS Council desires to improve the health and welfare of senior citizens by alleviating the costs of utility services;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 Council, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. NAME OF BYLAW

This bylaw shall be cited as the "Senior Citizen Exemption" Utility Bylaw.

2. DEFINITIONS:

- a) "Senior Citizen" means an individual who is 65 years of age and over.
- b) "Owner" means an individual who is the principle resident of the dwelling.
- c) "Utility services" means water, sewer and garbage pickup services.

3. That Senior Citizens living within the boundaries of the Municipal District of Opportunity are exempt from paying the utility services:

- a) 100% of water (main line or trucked delivery)
- b) 100% of sewer (main line or trucked vacuum)
- c) 100% of garbage pickup services


4. This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of third and final reading.

Read a third time and finally passed this 12th day of January 2005.
