

BYLAW 2005 - 3

OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17 In the Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 to amend the Senior Citizen Exemption Utility Bylaw.

WHEREAS Section 63 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, authorizes Council to amend a bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 Council, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. That the Senior Citizen Exemption Bylaw is amended to add under:
 2. DEFINITIONS:
 - e) "Deposit fee" means a fee payable by a consumer who is not the owner or purchaser of the building or lot that he/she is receiving utility services for.
2. That Clause 3 of the Senior Citizen Exemption Bylaw is amended to read:


"That Senior Citizens living within the boundaries of the Municipal District of Opportunity are exempt from paying the utility services and deposit fee" under the Senior Citizen Exemption Utility Bylaw.
3. This Bylaw shall take effect on the date of third and final reading.

Read a third time and finally passed this 9th day of March 2005.
