

## BYLAW 96 - 17

### OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17 In the Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 authorizing volunteer firefighters to use flashing green lights in their vehicles.

---

WHEREAS, by authority of an amendment to Section 59 of the Highway Traffic Act, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. A full time or volunteer firefighter may carry on or in a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or other emergency.
2. No person other than a full time or volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
3. Nothing in this section shall be construed so as to permit a full time or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of this Act, the regulations or a Municipal Bylaw.

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon final reading.


