## **BYLAW 96 - 17**

## OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17 In the Province of Alberta

Being a Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 authorizing volunteer firefighters to use flashing green lights in their vehicles.

WHEREAS, by authority of an amendment to Section 59 of the Highway Traffic Act, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. A full time or volunteer firefighter may carry on or in a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or other emergency.
- 2. No person other than a full time or volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
- 3. Nothing in this section shall be construed so as to permit a full time or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of this Act, the regulations or a Municipal Bylaw.

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon final reading.
