M.D. of Opportunity No 17 TRANSPORTATION POLICY

TITLE: GENERAL POLICY

EFFECTIVE DATE: APRIL 1, 1996

POLICY NUMBER: T.1

Purpose of Policy:

This policy is intended to ensure the provision of a safe and efficient transportation infrastructure within the limit of resources available to the municipality.

Policy Statements

- 1. Transportation services shall include the provision and maintenance of forestry and local roads, pedestrian and airport services in accordance with provincial requirements and local priorities.
- 2. Public safety will be of prime importance in the design of the transportation infrastructure and programs. Other important considerations will be the need to:
 - a) provide for the efficient movement of emergency services
 - b) balance levels of service with the resources available to the municipality
 - c) promote the economic well-being of the municipality
 - d) provide for the efficient movement of people, goods and services
- 3. Transportation services shall be carried out within the context of a long range plan which is developed as required.
- 4. Transportation policies will be reviewed on as required basis.
