TRANSPORTATION POLICY

TITLE: **GENERAL POLICY**

EFFECTIVE DATE: **APRIL 1, 1996**

POLICY NUMBER: **T.1**

Purpose of Policy:

This policy is intended to ensure the provision of a safe and efficient transportation infrastructure within the limit of resources available to the municipality.

Policy Statements

1. Transportation services shall include the provision and maintenance of forestry and local roads, pedestrian and airport services in accordance with provincial requirements and local priorities.
2. Public safety will be of prime importance in the design of the transportation infrastructure and programs. Other important considerations will be the need to:
 - a) provide for the efficient movement of emergency services
 - b) balance levels of service with the resources available to the municipality
 - c) promote the economic well-being of the municipality
 - d) provide for the efficient movement of people, goods and services
3. Transportation services shall be carried out within the context of a long range plan which is developed as required.
4. Transportation policies will be reviewed on as required basis.
