M.D. of Opportunity No 17 TRANSPORTATION POLICY

TITLE: ROAD GRAVELLING POLICY

EFFECTIVE DATE: APRIL 1, 1996

POLICY NUMBER: T.5

Purpose of Policy:

This policy is intended to set out the standards and process for gravelling municipal roads.

Policy Statements

- 1. Priority of expenditures shall be given to repairing soft spots on all roads before funds are allocated to the general gravelling program.
- 2. In planning the general gravelling program, priority shall be given to areas of the road in greatest need of gravelling but the program shall be coordinated to minimize costs.
- 3. Only approaches within the Municipality's road right of way limits and municipal community leases will be gravelled and then only on an as required basis as funds allow.
- 4. Gravelling programs shall generally be tendered to the private sector using a public bidding process. The successful bidder shall be chosen using a combination of lowest price combined with a demonstrated ability to successfully complete the work. M.D. equipment and staff may be used for small gravel projects, or to assist with a private contract project.
- 5. The M.D. shall use, where available, a combination of gravel stockpiles held by Alberta Transportation for our use, private stockpiles, and municipally-owned stockpiles. In any event, best price combined with the quality of the gravel will be the determining factor in which source is used.
