# BYLAW-2025-07

# A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF OPPORTUNITY NO. 17 In the Province of Alberta

To establish a permanent Electors Register in the municipality who are entitled to vote in an election.

WHEREAS Section 49 of the Local Authorities Election Act empowers a municipality, by bylaw, to prepare a permanent electors register of residents in the municipality who are entitled to vote in an election; and

WHEREAS this permanent electors register may be used for the Municipal Election or as otherwise authorized by Council and the Local Authorities Election Act;

**NOW THEREFORE** the council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts the following:

#### 1. Title:

a) This bylaw shall be cited as The Permanent Electors Register for the Municipal District of Opportunity.

### 2. Definitions:

In this Bylaw:

- a) "Municipality" means the corporation of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17;
- b) "Chief Administrative Officer" means the person appointed to the position of chief administration officer pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*.

## 3. Purpose:

The Chief Administrative Officer or his/her designate is authorized to:

- a) Establish the procedures and forms necessary to complete an enumeration in the communities of Wabasca, Calling Lake, Sandy Lake, Chipewyan Lake, Trout Lake, Peerless Lake, and Red Earth Creek;
- b) Establish methods of compiling and revising the permanent registry;
- c) Enter into an agreement with the Chief Electoral Officer under the Local Authorities Election Act to share information for the purpose of preparing a Provincial list of electors.
- 4. That Bylaw 2004 3 is hereby repealed.
- 5. That Bylaw 2025-07 shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.

Read a first time this 14th day of May, 2025.

Read a second time this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2025.

Read a third time and finally passed this 14th day of May, 2025.
