All-Park Improvements Project Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17



1. Introduction

The Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 invites qualified contractors to submit quotes for the **labour, supply of own tools, and equipment** required for the All-Park Improvements Project. This work will include construction, installation, and associated improvements across multiple park sites within the MD.

2. Scope of Work

The contractor will be responsible for providing all labour, tools, and equipment necessary to complete the park improvements. Work will include, but is not limited to:

Playground Improvements:

- Ground preparation and laying geotextile weed barrier control.
- Construction of swing set cribbing perimeter for sand containment using provided materials.
- Spread and level playground sand safety buffer to 12" layer as required.
- Install playground attachments (I.e. Swing sets, slides, climbing apparatus where required)

Cribbing Size Requirements:

- Install two tier 6x6 cribbing **40 ft x 60 ft** perimeter around swing set site.

Construction Specifications:

- Perimeter must be squared and staked securely to maintain proper shape and dimensions.
- Corners are to be overlapping joints to ensure stability.
- Ground must be leveled prior to cribbing installation.
- Geotextile weed barrier must be installed beneath the cribbing and sand area.

Additional Work May Include:

- Mobilization of materials and equipment
- Installation of playground components (slides, climbing apparatus, etc.)
- Site grading, drainage, and landscaping as required

Note: Materials will be provided by the MD unless otherwise noted. Any unforeseen items must be pre-approved.



3. Project Locations

4. Contractor Requirements

The successful contractor must provide:

- All necessary labour, tools, and equipment
- Valid Certificate of Liability Insurance
- Valid WCB coverage
- Valid MD Business Licence
- COR certification (if more than 10 workers on site)

5. Timeline

Work must be completed **before freezing conditions** in 2025. Contractor should provide a proposed schedule, including estimated start and completion dates for each park location.

6. Quote Submission

Quotes should include:

- Company information and contact details
- Relevant experience and qualifications
- Detailed cost breakdown (labour, equipment, any additional supply items)
- Proposed project schedule

7. Evaluation Criteria

Quotes will be evaluated on:

- Cost competitiveness
- Contractor experience and qualifications
- Demonstrated ability to complete projects within required timelines
- Safety record and certification compliance
- References and or past performance
