VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS:

You are eligible to vote if you are: At least 18 years of age, a Canadian citizen, your place of residence is located in the local jurisdiction on election day, October 20, 2025.

REGISTERED VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

All **registered** voters are required to show valid government issued identification containing, at minimum, the voters photograph and name.

If you are registered, it is recommended to use one of the following common types of identification:

- Alberta Drivers Licence or Identification Card
- Fishing, trapping or hunting license
- Government cheque or cheque stub
- Income/Property tax assessment notice
- Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee
- Statement of government benefits (e.g. Employment Insurance, old-age pension, social assistance, disability support or child tax benefits)

NON-REGISTERED VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

All Non-Registered Voters are Required to:

- 1. Complete a statement of elector eligibility that they are eligible to vote.
- Show valid government issued identification containing the voters photograph, name and current address.
 It is recommended to use one of the following common types of identification:
 - Alberta Drivers Licence
 - o Alberta Identification Card

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE PHOTO ID THAT VALIDATES YOUR NAME AND CURRENT ADDRESS

If you are a non-registered voter unable to produce government issued photo identification that validates your name and current address or your address has recently changed, you'll be required to provide one piece of **Valid**ID with your name and current address. It is recommended to use the following common types of identification:

- Bank/Credit Card Statement or Personal Cheque
- Insurance Policy or Coverage Card
- Pension Plan Benefit Statement
- Residential Lease or Mortgage Statement
- Utility Bill (e.g. telephone, utilities commission, television, hydro (electric), gas or water)
- Vehicle Ownership, registration or insurance certificate
