



BYLAW 2026-15

A Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of adopting a Land Use Bylaw for the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act R.S.A. 2000, as amended, requires the Council of the Municipality to enact a land use bylaw to regulate and control the use and development of land and buildings within the Municipality; and

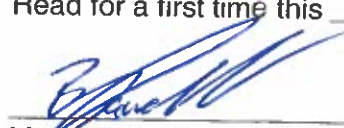
WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 deems it desirable, expedient and in the best interest of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 to adopt a new land use bylaw.

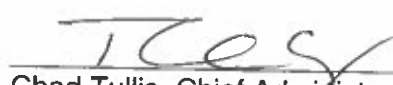
NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This new Bylaw may be cited as "The Land Use Bylaw".
2. The Land Use Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17 attached hereto as Schedule "A" to this Bylaw is hereby adopted.
3. Bylaw 2026-13 as amended, being the previous Land Use Bylaw of the Municipal District of Opportunity No. 17, is hereby repealed.
4. This Bylaw may be amended by Bylaw in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000, as amended.

This Bylaw comes into effect upon the date of the final reading thereof.
